### Vocabulary

- D: A Japanese teacher would understand, but there are many unnatural aspects.
- E: There are many unnatural aspects, and the listener often struggles to understand.

### Fluency

- A: Able to speak smoothly overall.
- B: Generally does not experience interruptions in speech.
- C: Some slight pauses or interruptions in conversation.
- D: Frequent pauses or interruptions in conversation.
- E: Frequent silences or long pauses.

### Exchange of Conversation

- A: Able to engage in natural exchanges of conversation.
- B: Able to engage in appropriate exchanges of conversation.
- C: Able to engage in exchanges of conversation to some extent.
- D: There are significant difficulties in exchanging conversation.
- E: The exchanges of conversation are unnatural.

### Sociolinguistic Competence
