**Panel discussions** A panel should comprise no more than 5 panelists. Panel discussions can include case studies to present the success of a project/team, achievements, and how barriers were overcome.

**Professional development sessions** These sessions should be organized in a workshop-like manner to teach strategies and/or skills related to inclusive leadership.

**Birds-of-a-feather/Shared interest sessions** These sessions are informal gatherings of people interested in a particular topic. They can feature a presentation, roundtable, or a demonstration followed by discussion, announcements, sharing of strategies, and the opportunity to network and meet new colleagues.
