## **Course Components:**

This course will use *Stretch 1* as a text. In this semester, we plan to cover Units 10-12 (pages 62-79).

**Vocabulary**: Vocabulary will include words used for speaking about cities, music and travel plans.

**Grammar**: Grammar topics for this semester focus on wh- questions with the past of **be**, invitations and suggestions, future plans with **be going to** and **might**.

**Speaking**: This class is focused on speaking. Expect to spend 50% of the time in class communicating in English with your peers. Skills in focus for this semester include showing surprise, accepting and declining invitations, and showing enthusiasm.

**Listening**: Listening skills will be developed using authentic conversations and audio-visual materials to gather overall ideas and specific information. Students will learn the skills of listening for descriptions, opinions and plans.

**Reading and writing:** Reading comprehension abilities will be enhanced through a variety of exercises focusing primarily on English materials. Students will receive guided practice for showing the order of events, scanning, editing and revising.

**Presenting:** Participants' will learn the skills of using rhetorical questions, focusing their presentations and using repetition. They will present on a city they want to visit, a music venues and a vacation destination.
