Hope FAQ

What Curriculum and textbooks are used?

In Elementary they follow the International Primary Curriculum and in middle school the International Middle Years Curriculum, both of which align with British education standards. They provide project-based learning lessons, where the activities are often student led.

What entrance examinations are there?

Students must take a reading and mathematics assessment test. Math is taught at an advanced rate and so Hope will seek to ensure that students will be successful in the classroom.

What afterschool options are available?

From Jan 2020, hope will offer the following afterschool options; Robotics, Sanshin (Okinawan guitar), Green club, Running, Ukulele, Photojournalism.

What are the different nationalities of students represented?

Japanese (60%), American, Filipino, Argentinian, Cameroonian.

What big school trips are available during the year?

Students partake in 3 school wide trips per year to local destinations. Each class takes part in 1 trip per semester. There are opportunities to go on a school camp where students can have outdoor education experiences.

What is currently being developed at the school?

They will have a high school program starting from 2020, which will run the very successful Cambridge syllabus. They have recently built new classrooms to accommodate growth of the school.

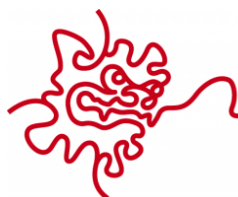
What additional support is provided for students?

Additional literacy support will be provided to students who are struggling, it is expected that students will have a certain minimum level of English ability prior to joining the school.

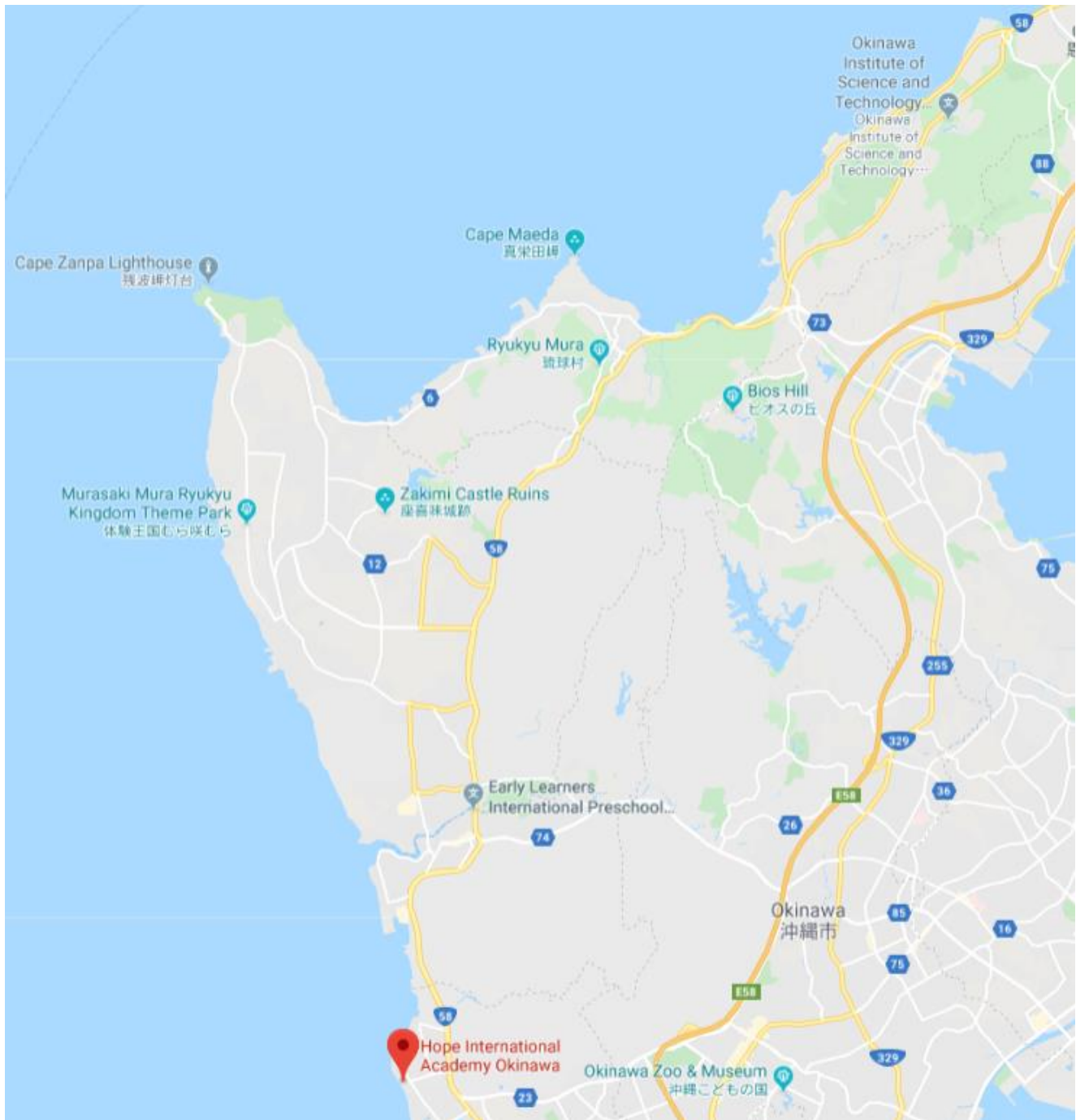
What are the student numbers for each section?
