
Creates shifts and covers the classroom when class teachers are on leave.

Overview of Class


Infants will join the class from April 1 and will remain in this class until end of March 2023.

- Class Dojo or Email








Outcomes

- Sits and stands without support
- Walks independently
- Sit in a chair independently
- Holds a Sippy cup to dink with assistance
- Feeds themselves finger food
- Begins to use utensils to eat
- Use few Baby Sign Language to express their feelings













Baby Sign Language



- Infant class provides sign language in daytime childcare
- Communicating in sign language can help babies and toddlers overcome a lot of the frustration.
- Baby sign promotes communication before a child is able to verbally communicate with others.

- Please sign in on the attendance sheet each day.
- Please put away your child's belongings in the designated area.


Afternoon Pick Up

- Please sign out on the attendance sheet each day.
- Children will not be released to any other person who is not designated for Alternative Pick-Up Authorization.
- Bottles, cup, containers for lunch and snack, and dirty clothes should be taken home each day. Diapers are kept in CDC.
- Please take home your child's bed sheet and blanket on the last day of the week.
- We open from 8:00 a.m.- 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday. A late fee of ¥1,000 will be charged for every 15 minutes after 6:00 p.m

•Please bring four or five bottles of prepared milk to the class every day.






Please bring an extra bottle for your child.


About Snacks and School Lunch
