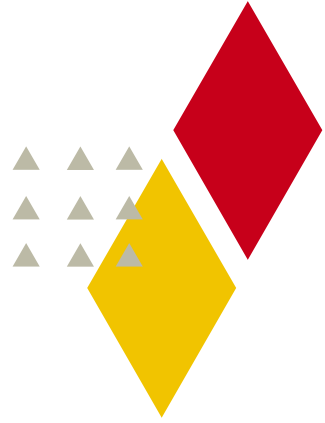


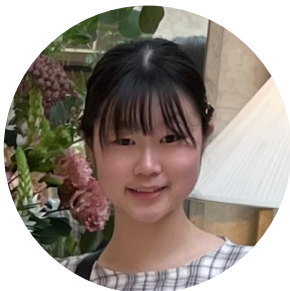
Campers 1-5

Ami IJIMA Camp Leader

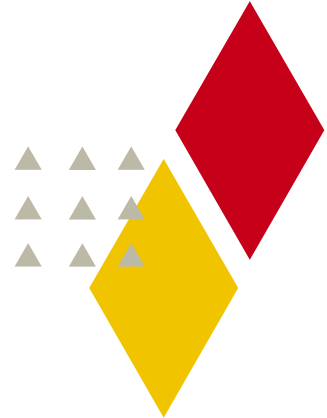

Ibuki SANO

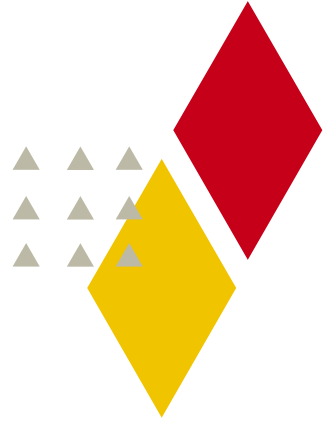

Aya NAGAO

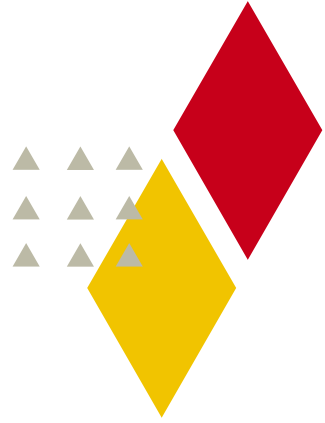
