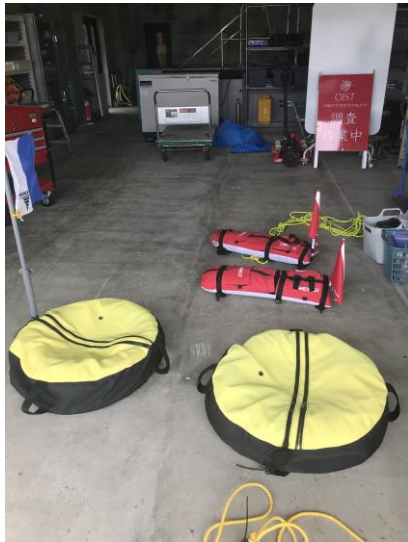

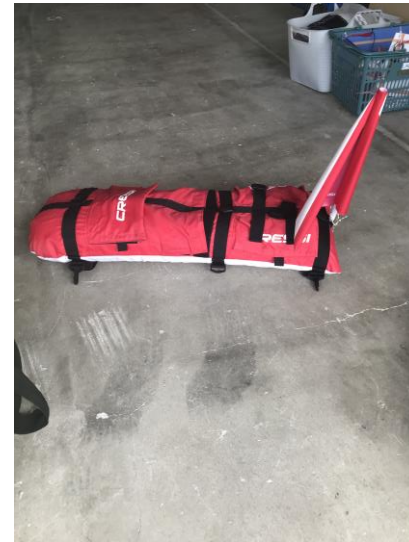

What is a Buoy?

- There are various types of buoy, but all are floating devices that are carried by snorkelers and divers to indicate their position and visually notify to the surrounding boats and people the location of the snorkelers/divers.
- They are usually made with bright colored materials for easy identification from afar. Common colors are **red**, fluorescent **orange**, **yellow**, or **pink**.



Donut type

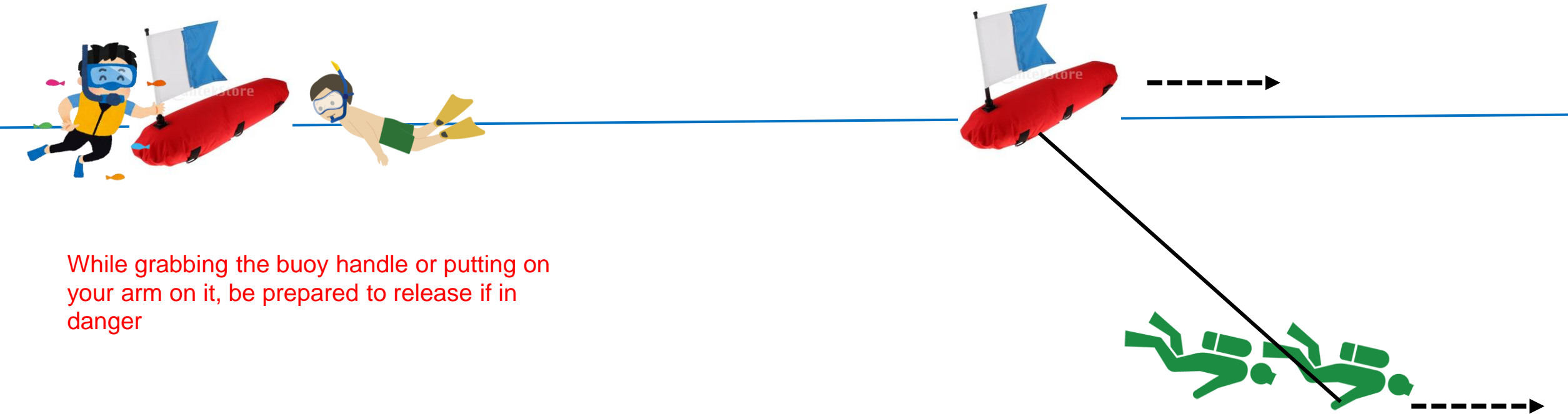


Square type

Example : Use of Buoy with dive flag



While grabbing the buoy handle or putting on your arm on it, be prepared to release if in danger



Hold the rope: When you pull the buoy, keep the rope in your hand

Release if Tangled: Be ready to let go quickly if the rope might wrap around you or get caught on a boat.

Use a Knife: If you can't untangle the rope, cut it with a knife.
