

Epson iProjection

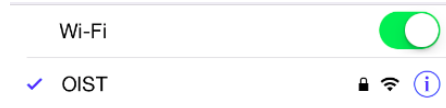
The iProjection App can be used to project Photos, Documents loaded into the app and Web Pages.

Note: Audio, video, or Adobe Flash content cannot be projected via the iProjection web browser.

Document Types Supported: Word, PowerPoint, Excel, Keynote, PDF, JPG, TIFF, PNG



NOTE: Ensure your device is connected to the OIST Wi-Fi Network.



Download App

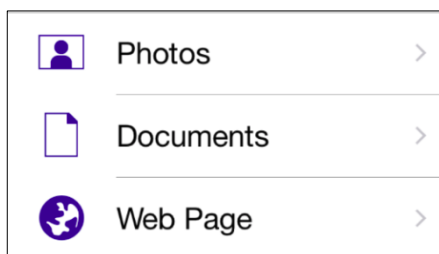
1. Go to the App Store on your device and search iProjection.
2. Install the app.

Connect to Projector

1. Turn on the Projector, and press the **LAN** button on the projector's remote control.
2. Launch the Epson iProjection app, and tap on **Projector** (top right), to open the **Search Projector** screen.
3. Tap **Other**. Enter the projector's IP address in the **IP Address** field. **Note:** The IP address is displayed on the projector screen after pressing the **LAN** button on the remote control.
4. Tap the name of your projector in the list of available projectors, and tap **Connect** (top right).
5. Tap **OK** when prompted to confirm the connection to the projector.



Access photos from your photo album to display.

Project documents such as PowerPoint/Keynote slides. However, you must preload them. See note below.

You can view web pages.

NOTE: To project Documents, you must first upload them to your device with iTunes. Please go to <http://goo.gl/9zGt1E> for detailed instructions on managing documents with iProjection.
